2022 Leaf Collection Season – November 7, 2022 to December 2, 2022

40 bags of leaves per week are permitted in addition to your regular trash. Please place leaves in the same location you put out your trash (curb or alley) but keep them 3-5 feet away from your trash. Leaves should not be set out loose in cans.

What Happened in October?

October 17th

Mayor Hogsett and the Greater Indianapolis Progress Committee (GIPC) awarded community leader, volunteer, and current CEO of the Central Indiana Corporate Partnership (CICP), David Johnson with the <u>2022 Charles L. Whistler Award</u>

<u>2023 Budget Passage</u>: Historic funding for public safety, infrastructure, more passed in bipartisan vote by City-County Council.

October 21st

Mayor Hogsett and the Department of Metropolitan Development (DMD) released <u>222 North Alabama Street Redevelopment Project Request for Proposals</u>, a redevelopment opportunity for 222 N. Alabama St., a downtown parking lot north of Old City Hall.

October 28th

Department of Metropolitan Development (DMD) was awarded a \$35 million allocation of New Markets Tax Credits from the U.S. Department of Treasury. DMD estimates the \$35 million award will generate at least \$90 million in new development.

October 31st

City of Indianapolis Office of Minority and Women Business Development (OMWBD) selects a women and veteran-owned business enterprise, <u>GroundBreakers Hydrovac Excavation Services LLC</u>, for its second Vendor of the Month.
